



ITEMS NOT COUNTED AS CARRY-ON (US FLIGHTS)

The following are examples of items that are **not counted** as carry-on baggage for passengers travelling to the United States. Unless otherwise stated, the items must be carried on the person, and not inside a larger bag.

FOOD AND MEDICATION	ANIMALS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ small snacks and other foods (liquid and gel restrictions apply) ▪ prescription medication ▪ essential non-prescription medication 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ pets in carrying cases (with airline approval) ▪ service animals and their equipment
CHILDREN'S TOYS	OTHER
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ colouring books ▪ crayons ▪ small stuffed animals 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ musical instruments in purpose-designed carrying cases ▪ cameras (still and video) and accessories in purpose-designed carrying cases <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - includes film, lenses, spare batteries, chargers, cables - includes large, professional-grade cameras and equipment ▪ knitting needles (when wool is present) ▪ religious items (e.g., prayer mat, etc.)

FURTHER GUIDANCE ON CARRY-ON ITEMS (US FLIGHTS)

ACCEPTABLE

Small purses or pouches
25 cm x 30 cm x 14 cm
(10 in x 12 in x 5½ in)

- applies equally to women, men and children



NOT ACCEPTABLE

Large purses, attaché cases and briefcases



Laptops and accessories in regular carrying case



Laptops in suitcases or "on wheels"
